The American Dental Association (ADA) and Georgia Dental Association (GDA) have recommended that dentists postpone elective dental procedures to reduce the spread of COVID-19.

We want to ensure the safety of our patients and team, and to be good community partners by helping to reduce the spread of the virus. In accordance with these recommendations, we will postpone elective dental procedures until the risk of the virus spread begins to subside and we can resume normal care for our patients.

The ADA and the GDA have strongly urged dentists to continue to see patients who have dental emergencies or who cannot delay dental care. This will “help alleviate the burden that dental emergencies would place on hospital emergency departments.” Therefore, our office will remain open and we will continue to treat patients with dental emergencies and those patients who cannot delay dental care. If patients have a dental emergency they should call our office to make an appointment.
